

COMMON PROBLEMS

PLATERS IGNORE

INCONSISTENT QUALITY

SOLUTION —

WORK BACKWARDS (ask for Technical Bulletin TF-149) or proceed step by step — Start with a filter and granular carbon chamber on the rinse before plating. Move back and do the same on the etch and electroclean. Then let's talk about extending the life of your cleaner - prevent carry over of solids and oil to the plating tank.

ORGANIC CONTAMINATION

SOLUTION —

If you use powdered carbon which takes up 80% of solids holding space when pre-coated on the filter media, it's messy. Instead, to more easily remove organic contamination, employ a granular carbon chamber following prefiltration which purifies slowly over a 6 - 8 week cycle with easy "white carbon" replacement. (Ask for Technical Bulletin TF-133)

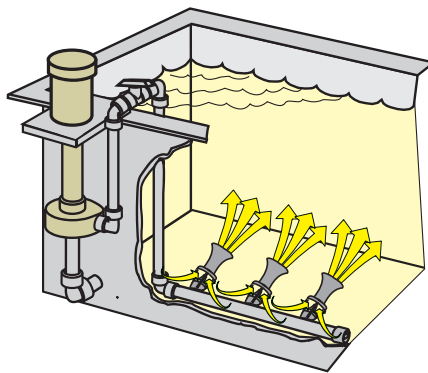
INEFFICIENT AGITATION

SOLUTION —

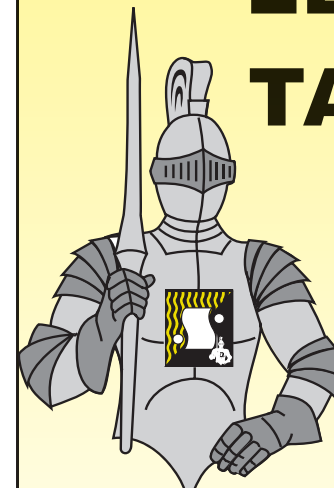
